3. All new tenants receive information and a welcome from the relevant association if this is provided to the Allotments Office - Julian to check what is going out from us presently and bring back to future HAA meeting.

4. SCC state that they are open to associations self-managing water supply and have a contract with Rodney Hill facilitating such an arrangement. Julian to check such an arrangement would be available to HAA and to request a copy of the SCC - Rodney Hill contract.
